### • REINU POTTERY WORKSHOP

Our master potter will let you in on all of the secrets of the world of pottery and show you the different ways in which potters work. You will get the chance to make your very own Angla souvenir – a wall tile, soap dish, vase, plate, bowl or cup. Unfired items can be taken with you immediately. To turn clay into ceramics, however, takes one week. You can come and collect your fired souvenirs or organise to have them sent to you.

## VILIDU FELT WORKSHOP

We will give you an overview of the ways in which felt items are made and what felt can be used for. Under the watchful eye of our felt master you can make your own felt accessories and souvenirs to mark any occasion – Valentine’s Day, Easter, Mothers Day, Christmas and more.

You can even try felting the Angla Windmill Hill logo if you like!

We use felting wool as our basic material. Children can try creating a picture using the wet felting technique.

## • VIITA WOOL WORKSHOP

Guided by our master wool crafter, you will become privy to ancient woolly wisdom and learn how wool used to be spun in the olden days!

We use genuine lamb’s wool straight from the local countryside.

You will find out about the spinning traditions in local folk culture, as well as how wool is combed, special spinning techniques and more.

At the workshop you can knit your own part of the ever-expanding Angla carpet, recording your visit and writing it into our cultural heritage!

## • LAUSE LEATHER AND STONE WORKSHOP

### Leatherwork:

Our leather master will tell you about the history of leatherwork, how it is used and what it can be used for. Under their guidance you can try

your hand at making a leather wristband or necklace or other items, including a leather bag.

Group size: 15 people

Ages: 6–100

### Stonework:

You will find out where dolomite comes from, what it is used for and what makes the local dolomite unique. Guided by our stone master, you will learn simple methods of engraving. You can produce images of the windmills, something related to your family, symbols and more.

Group size: 15–20 people

Ages: 10–100



- **TEDRE JEWELLERY WORKSHOP AND BLACKSMITHS**

Our blacksmith will tell you about the history of the trade and its importance in the everyday lives of the farming families of Angla. You can try your hand at simple smithy tasks and feel for yourself the full weight and power of the blacksmith's hammer!

- **ANGLA WOOD WORKSHOP**

You will hear all about the history of woodwork and the ways in which the wood itself is worked. Under the watchful eye of our master craftsman you can make something from local Saaremaa juniper, renowned for its lovely scent, as a souvenir of your visit to Angla

Windmill Hill.

## VISITORS WILL ALSO ENJOY

**ANGLA BAKERY** where, booked in advance, folk events can be organised for groups with:

- workshop activities; and
- tasting freshly baked bread and salted butter.

Catering is also available from Kaali Tavern if required. Bread-baking courses can also be held if booked in advance. (Price on agreement.)

**CONFERENCE ROOM** on the second floor of the building, where in addition to conferences and seminars a range of cultural events can also be held: folk and classical concerts, events marking special days in the folk calendar, group activities, company events, family get-togethers and more.

There is a small museum exhibition on this floor. Catering is also available from Kaali Tavern if required.

**HANDICRAFT COURSES** in our workshops: from silk screening and flower arranging to drawing and painting. (Ask us for the full list of courses.)

These courses are designed for groups of at least 10 people.

Training days and events for school groups of up to 30 people can also be held here.
